Dear Secretary Mayorkas,

With the ongoing reports of unidentified unmanned aircraft systems (UAS) sightings in southeastern Pennsylvania, I urgently request the Department of Homeland Security deploy additional resources to the state. While federal briefings indicate there is no immediate threat to public safety, it is imperative our communities in Pennsylvania are protected and questions on the presence of these drones are answered.

Specifically, I am requesting the Department of Homeland Security deploy appropriate drone-tracking technology. Special drone detection systems are necessary to understand the flight patterns and security risks posed by these UAS. As they appear to move into Pennsylvania from New York and New Jersey, state-of-the-art radar systems will provide insights into where these drones are deploying from and what the motives for their flights may be.

Pennsylvanians should not have to be afraid of what may be flying over their homes or over areas of critical infrastructure. It is critical that the Department of Homeland Security provide the necessary technology and drone detection resources to Pennsylvania, as well as continue to collaborate effectively with local and state authorities in your investigation.
