I am requesting funding for the **Trumbauersville Fire Company Public Safety Facility Replacement Project** in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is **Redevelopment Authority of the County of Bucks, located at 216 Pond Street, Bristol, PA, 19007.**

The funding would be used to **build a new, modern fire station that includes bunk rooms for on-site crews during emergency situations, HazMat safety areas with decontamination showers, and a larger engine bay to properly house emergency vehicles and improve response capabilities.** The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because **the current building's structural and infrastructure issues limit operational efficiency and poses long-term safety and maintenance challenges. Investing in a new facility will ensure that Trumbauersville Fire Company can continue protecting residents and supporting first responders with reliable, modern emergency response infrastructure for decades to come.**

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is consistent with purposes authorized in **42 U.S.C. 5305(a)(2).**
