## **RESOLUTION**

- Recognizing August 6, National Night Out, the national coming together of Americans all over the Nation to unite and promote public safety.
- Whereas, on the first Tuesday of August, the Nation will observe National Night Out, a day to cultivate a better relationship between residents of a community and their local law enforcement, and to promote public safety;
- Whereas the participation in National Night Out by over 38,000,000 neighbors in over 16,000 communities across the United States for over 40 years is inspiring;
- Whereas the relationship between local law enforcement and the residents which they are sworn to protect is important in creating a true sense of community;

Whereas general awareness of public safety has improved, because of the continued efforts of communities to meet their law enforcement officers and participate in National Night Out activities; and

Whereas National Night Out not only includes Americans on the mainland, but includes those in United States territories and military bases to ensure all are included in the effort of community building and public safety awareness: Now, therefore, be it
